

BUTLER COUNTY OUTREACH

The following programs and services are available in Butler County for individuals and families, regardless of religious affiliation, in their time of great need.

Basic Needs Assistance

- Food and clothing.
- Help with paying utility bills in conjunction with the Utility Integrated Point of Contact (UIPOC) at the Center for Community Resources. May include Dollar Energy Fund, deliverable fuel, or other utility assistance.

Disaster Relief

For assistance following a fire, flood or other natural disaster, contact the Red Cross for a referral. They will send the referral directly to us.

Housing and Homeless Assistance

First point of contact for homeless assistance in Butler County. Through case management, each individual is evaluated to determine the appropriate program or community resource.

- ***Emergency Shelter.*** Shelter for a limited number of days for homeless individuals and families.
- ***Emergency Solutions Grant.*** Housing relocation and stabilization services and rental assistance, to re-house the homeless, and prevent individuals or families from becoming homeless.
- ***Home Again.*** Permanent supportive housing for ***families with children***, who struggle with mental health. Includes vocational and education assistance, life-skills training, rental subsidies, linkage to substance abuse and mental health treatment.
- ***PATH.*** Permanent supportive housing for ***homeless individuals ages 18 to 24 years old*** with co-occurring mental health and drug and alcohol issues. Includes vocational and education assistance, life-skills training, rental subsidies, linkage to substance abuse and mental health treatment.

Housing and Homeless Assistance, *continued.* . .

- **Rent Assistance.** For individuals or families experiencing a housing crisis and are in danger of being evicted, or are requesting assistance with first month's rent to prevent a homeless situation.
- **Safe Harbor Program.** Temporary accommodations and supportive services to homeless individuals and families who are motivated to become self-sufficient.

Pregnancy and Parenting Support Services

- Prenatal education, supportive counseling and education for pregnant and parenting women, biological fathers and legal guardians, from pregnancy up to age two of the infant.
- Free baby care items.
- Free pregnancy tests.
