

The Catholic Charities Lawrence County Outreach provides assistance to individuals and families in their time of need. Our programs and services are dedicated to preserving life, sustaining families, and helping to improve the quality of life of all who come to us, regardless of religious affiliation. Services provided include:

Pregnancy and Parenting Support

- Prenatal education, supportive counseling and education for pregnant and parenting women, biological fathers and legal guardians, from pregnancy up to age two of the infant.
- Free baby care items.
- Free pregnancy tests.

Anger Management

Helps people manage their emotions and behavior in an age appropriate way. Adult and adolescent male and female groups, and individual counseling are available.

Parenting Classes

Stress Management, Improved Parenting Communication Skills, Positive Parenting and Effective Discipline to aid parents in raising children through their teenage years.

Family Communication Classes

Teaches positive parenting techniques and behavior management strategies to help increase positive behavior, decrease negative behavior, and model appropriate alternative behavior for children.

Basic Needs Assistance

- Limited financial assistance for utilities including assistance through Dollar Energy and CAP programs.
- Food, clothing and personal hygiene items. Must attend a one-hour group session to qualify for assistance.

Disaster Relief

For assistance following a fire, flood or other natural disaster, contact the Red Cross for a referral. They will send the referral directly to us.

Community Referrals and Follow-Up

Referrals for food, clothing, housing, public assistance and other emergency needs not available through Catholic Charities' Lawrence County Outreach. After a referral is made, a follow-up with the individual or family is done to be sure they were able to access the referral service/s.
