## **GREENE COUNTY OUTREACH**

The following programs, services and resources are available to Greene County residents, regardless of religious affiliation, to help them through difficult times to meet and maintain their needs, with self-reliance, dignity and respect.

### **Pregnancy and Parenting Support Services**

- Prenatal education, supportive counseling and education for pregnant and parenting women, biological fathers and legal guardians, from pregnancy up to age two of the infant.
- Free baby care items.
- FREE pregnancy tests.
- Home visits may be available. Call for more information.

### **Counseling**

- Adults—individual, couples, family, gambling addiction, anger management.
- Parenting—for raising children through their teenage years.
- Co-Parenting and Trans-Parenting—working with parents to understand how divorce/separation affects children and how to help children adjust in a healthy way.
- Children and adolescents—addresses changes affecting their lives such as divorce, death, moving, and bullying (also as an in-school program called *Rollercoasters* for children K-5).

### **Basic Needs Assistance**

- Limited financial assistance for utilities including assistance through Dollar Energy and CAP programs.
- Food and clothing

Professional clothing to obtain or maintain employment. Gasoline voucher for job interviews or within the first two weeks of a new job.

Holiday gifts for children ages 18 and younger.
